Penn Energy

Duncan reported we requested that Penn Energy complete the contract they have entered into with the Excess Maintenance Agreement and pave Brewer and Westminster Road. The township is waiting to hear back from Penn Energy

#### **COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT**

#### **ROAD DEPARTMENT**

- Motion by Duncan to approve and accept the low bid of \$21,635.00 for the Salt Storage Structure Roof from Wecover. Second by Halstead. Motion passed.
- Motion by Duncan for the Township to pay for signs for Private Lanes. Second by Halstead. Motion passed.
- Motion by Halstead to approve and accept the June/July 2020 Road Report. Second by Duncan. Motion passed.

#### August 10 Road Report

- Working on Hidden Hill Rd installing 520 ft of 24 inch pipe along the berm of the road. The job is about completed.
- Ordered more #3 stone.
- Ordered more pipe for Hidden Hill project and Cherry Valley Rd project.
- Cleaned catch basins, and cross pipes off.
- Have been installing street signs throughout the township.
- Have been spreading 1B special on the roads for when the oil bleeds up.
- The township roads have all been mowed. We are working on the second go around of the roads.
- Roads that have been mowed are Hidden Hill, Stark, Goldscheitter, Victory Rd, North Noah Dr, Spring Valley Rd, Kozy Korner Rd, Alderson Rd, Sandy Hill Rd, Tower Rd, Knoch Rd, Rachel Dr, McKay Rd, and Monk Rd.
- The John Deere 6605 Ditcher has arrived at Stephenson Equipment. The tractor will go up in the next couple of weeks to be installed.
- Met with Cory Shaffer PennDOT Municipal Rep. We went over Deer Creek Rd Paving Project, and I gave him a list of roads
  that will need tar and chipped for next year. He is supposed to get a price quote in the next couple of days.
- I am still waiting to hear back from Joe Schwab from Penn Energy. In regard to trucks driving on Brewer Rd, Albin Rd. They are supposed to look into fixing the roads and getting back to the township with a solution.
- Rick Murray is completed with the Callen Rd Road Project. Rick gave a price of \$3,500 to install a cross pipe on Cherry Valley Rd. It would be to install 5 sticks of 48inch pipe. The work is supposed to get done before school starts.
- The Knoch Rd sewer project is completed. Everything is up to spec.
- Darrian Rickets U.S. Municipal Sales Rep. Gave a price on a 2020 Ford FSS0 gas dump truck. After comparing it to Stephenson Equipment truck. U.S. Municipal truck was by far better, and the price was better than Stephenson Equipment. So, we moved forward in purchasing a new 2020 Ford FSS0 Gas Dump Truck through U.S. Municipal
- Are New Peterbilt 10-ton truck should be completed by the end of October.
- Tom Hartwig is still in discussion with the Victory Rd, and Cannon Hill Rd Bridge Project.
- Eric from Traisr has been working with the township on entering all of the data and information we need for Traisr.
- The 2016 Ford 550 was at Butler County Ford. The check engine light was on. They replaced a Nox Sensor. It was covered under warranty.
- Bill Shaw Stephenson Equipment, and Alan Seigworth Seigworth Road Supply gave a price quote on a new drop deck side
- Met with Peoples gas on Aug 6<sup>th</sup> the discussion was on them fixing Cannon Hill Rd, and Sandy Hill Rd. People gas is going to
  fix all the marks that the township had marked out on both roads

Victory Road Bridge

Hartwig reported that plans for the Bridge replacement are moving along. Hartwig stated they are still working on the Multimodal Grant. He is also in communication with Joe Sailor from the CDC.

Cannon Hill

Hartwig stated Arcadis has submitted the application for the Emergency GC11 permit. When the permit is received the township can place the order for the culvert.

Range Resources

Hartwig stated he has been in contact with Range Resources and they are doing the repair on Callen Rd. He suggested we should notify Range in writing to the fact we are aware they will make any additional repairs when it is needed, reminded them the roads are still bonded, and it is the Township expectation that all roads will be paved when the job is completed.
