#### CALL TO ORDER

#### PUBLIC HEARING

**THE PURPOSE:** Ordinance No. 2024-01, “The Clinton Township Fire Hydrant Tax Ordinance,” AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CLINTON, BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING A FIRE HYDRANT TAX. The proposed Ordinance would amend Chapter 155 of the Code of the Township of Clinton to establish a fire hydrant tax pursuant to the authority granted under Section 1802(a)(1) of The Second Class Township Code. 53 P.S. § 66802(a)(1). The tax shall be an equal assessment upon all property, whether or not exempt from taxation by existing law, within seven hundred and eighty feet of any fire hydrant based upon the assessment of property for Butler County tax purposes. A system of fire hydrants, provided, maintained, and operated by a water utility company, exists within the Township. The purpose of the proposed tax is to assess the Township’s annual costs of providing, maintaining, and operating the fire hydrant system upon those properties that benefit from the system. The Board of Supervisors of Clinton Township has judged that the imposition of this tax is necessitated to alleviate the financial burden of Township residents paying their share of the Township’s annual costs of providing, maintaining, and operating the fire hydrant system which residents do not benefit from the fire hydrant system. The Township estimates that the revenue to be derived from the tax will be \$12,160.56 annually.
